~Wineries~

Taylor Brooke Winery:

Produces a premium line of high quality vinifera and specialty wines. These wines have been developed by the winemaker/owner, Dick Auger, in a very unique way; involving friends and family to taste and comment on the wines during development. This broad spectrum of pallets helped create wines that appeal to a wide variety of wine drinkers; from the novice to the connoisseur. The wines are produced from their own grapes as well as fruit and juices procured locally and nationally.



Sharpe Hill Vineyard:

Sharpe Hill Vineyard has received over 250 medals in International tastings and is located in the town of Pomfret. The Tasting Room is open year round to the public for wine tastings and for the purchase of wine every Friday, Saturday, and Sunday from 11:00am to 5:00pm.

~Directions~

From the Inn to Taylor Brook Winery:

Head southeast on Plain Hill Rd toward CT-171/Somers Turnpike. Turn right at CT 171/Somers Turnpike. End at 848 Route 171 on the Left.

From Taylor Brook to 85 Main

Head southeast on CT-171/Route 171 toward Rocky Hill Rd 2.9 mi. Turn right at CT-169/CT-171/Route 169. Continue to follow CT-171 3.3 mi. Turn right at Kennedy Dr 0.6 mi. Turn left at Pomfret St/US-44 335 ft . Turn right at Main St. 85 Main will be on the left 79 ft

85 Main to the Inn

Head northwest on Main St toward Front St/US-44 79 ft. Turn right at Front St/US-44. Continue to follow US-44 0.5 mi. Turn left at CT-171/Providence St Continue to follow CT-171 3.5 mi. Continue on CT-169/Route 169 0.8 mi. Sharp left at Plaine Hill Rd. The Inn will be on the right 0.2 mi

The Inn to Sharpe Hill Vineyard

Head northwest on Plaine Hill Rd toward CT-169/Route 169 0.2 mi. Sharp right at CT-169/Route 169 1.1 mi. Turn right to stay on CT-169/Route 169. Continue to follow CT-169 4.8 mi. Slight right at Averill Rd/US-44 0.5 mi. Turn right at Hartford Providence Turnpike/Mashamoquet Rd/US-44 2.1 mi. Turn left at CT-97/Hampton Rd/Ye Old Windham Rd 1.8 mi. Turn left at Brooklyn Rd 1.4 mi. Turn right at Wade Rd. Sharpe Hill Vineyard's will be on the left 0.5 mi

Sharpe Hill Vineyard to the Inn

Head northeast on Wade Rd toward Cherry Hill Rd 0.5 mi. Turn left at Cherry Hill Rd 249 ft. Continue straight onto Brooklyn Rd 0.4 mi. Turn right at Jericho Rd/Weaver Rd 0.9 mi. Turn left at Jericho Rd/Murray Rd 0.6 mi. Slight left at Wolf Den Rd 1.3 mi. Turn right at Hartford Providence Turnpike/Mashamoquet Rd/US-44 1.5 mi. Turn left at Averill Rd/US-44. Continue to follow US-44 2.7 mi. Continue on CT-169/Norwich Worcester Turnpike/Pomfret St/School Rd. Continue to follow CT-169 2.6 mi. Turn left at CT-169/CT-171/Route 169. Continue to follow CT-169/Route 169 1.1 mi . Sharp left at Plaine Hill Rd

The Inn to Vienna Restaurant

Head northwest on Plaine Hill Rd toward CT-169/Route 169 0.2 mi. Slight left at CT-169/Route 169. Entering Massachusetts 6.1 mi. Continue on RT-169/N Woodstock Rd. Continue to follow RT-169 3.8 mi. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Main St/RT-131 0.7 mi. Slight left at South St. Vienna Restaurant & Historic Inn will be on the right 276 ft

Vienna Restaurant to the Inn

Head east on South St toward Main St/RT-131 276 ft. Slight right at Main St/RT-131 0.7 mi. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto E Main St/RT-131/RT-169 0.6 mi. Slight right at RT-169/N Woodstock Rd. Continue on CT-169/Route 169 6.1 mi. Slight right at Plaine Hill Rd
